2. Primary lesions

5. Eczemas (incl. allergic contact dermatitis, irritant contact dermatitis, dyshidrosiform and microbial eczema)
6. Dermatologic topical therapy (incl. vehicles, active ingredients)
7. Sarcoidosis. Granuloma annulare. Tuberculosis of the skin. Leprosy
8. Drug eruptions (Type I-IV reactions)
9. Phototherapy and photochemotherapy
10. Fungal infection of the skin (incl. superficial mycoses, deep mycoses, pityriasis versicolor)
11. Fungal infection of the nail, scalp and mucous membrane
12. Dermatologic surgery and aesthetic procedures
13. Acne, rosacea, perioral dermatitis, seborrheic dermatitis
14. Lyme disease. Scabies. Pediculosis
15. Bacterial infection of the skin (incl. impetigo, ecthyma, paronychia, folliculitis, furuncle, carbuncle, anthrax)
16. Superficial thrombophlebitis. Chronic venous insufficiency
17. Skin and internal diseases (incl. paraneoplastic syndrome, pruritus)
18. Ulcus cruris
19. Atopic dermatitis
20. Syphilis
21. Psoriasis
22. Sexually transmitted infections (incl. gonorrhea, urethritis non-gonorrhoea, other venereal diseases)
23. Lichen planus. Pityriasis rosea. Erythroderma
24. Erysipelas. Cellulitis. Necrotizing soft tissue infections (incl. fasciitis necrotisans)
25. Erythema multiforme. Stevens-Johnson syndrome. Lyell's syndrome
26. Skin symptoms of diabetes mellitus and inflammatory bowel disease (incl. erythema nodosum, pyoderma gangrenosum)
27. Mycosis fungoides. Sezary-syndrome. Kaposi's sarcoma
28. Cutaneous vasculitis
29. Photodermatoses (incl. porphyria cutanea tarda, photoallergic and phototoxic skin reactions, PLE)
30. Hair diseases.
31. Autoimmune bullous diseases (incl. pemphigus, pemphigoid, dermatitis herpetiformis)
32. HPV- and Pox-virus induced skin infections. Viral exanthems
33. CDLE, SCLE, SLE. Dermatomyositis. Progressive systemic sclerosis. Morphea
34. Pathogenesis of AIDS, skin symptoms of HIV infection
35. Burns, burn disease. Congelatio
36. Benign skin tumours (incl. tumours of the epidermis, fat and connective tissue, cysts, vascular nevi)
37. Pigment cell nevi. Vitiligo
38. Malignant melanoma
39. Precancerous tumours, in situ malignomas, squamous cell carcinoma. Basal cell carcinoma
40. Herpes simplex, herpes genitalis. Herpes zoster
41. Acute, life threatening skin conditions (incl. anaphylaxis, burn, Lyell's syndrome, pemphigus, erythroderma, necrotizing soft tissue infections)
